



# Rules

**CLASS:** Unlimited (No age limitation)

**PLAYER:** Each team will be allowed to carry ten (10) players. Changes may not be made after entry form is submitted. **No exceptions!** No player will be allowed to play for more than one team.

- The Chinese Christian Union reserves its rights to exclude player(s) from any team(s) because of misconduct. Two (2) unsportsmanlike "technical" fouls on any player, coach or manager results in automatic ejection from the game.

**ENTRY FEE:** **\$375.00** per team for the Upper Division.  
**\$300.00** per team for the Lower Division

**ENTRY DUE:** **Completed entry form** and **fee** must be **submitted together** to **Jason Lee, 1875 – 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue, San Francisco, CA 94122** by **Monday, January 30th, 2011.**

**TOURNAMENT:** All games will be played at El Camino High School in South San Francisco. **Tournament dates** are February 11 & 12, 2012. Schedule of games shall be sent out no later than Friday, February 10, 2012.

- Games will be played as scheduled. **No Exceptions!** All games will be played at the El Camino High School. An Upper Division game will consist of two (2) twenty minute halves, **semi stop-time** (timeouts & Free Throws), except when the "spread" is more than twenty (20) points. College rules, but because of no 35-second shot clock, closely guarded and held ball rule will be enforced. (4 seconds with maximum of 12 seconds). **During the last 2 minutes of the second half, clock stops on every whistle.** Five (5) minutes stop time for each overtime. A Lower Division game will consist of two (2) twenty minutes running halves with the exception of the last 2 minutes of each half where it will be full stop. The first overtime period will be 2 minutes and the second overtime will be sudden death. There will be 2 timeouts per half with no carry-over. Backcourt pressure (press) by the leading team is not permitted if that team has a lead of 20-points or more. The clock will run in the last 2 minutes of the second half if a team is leading by 20 points or more.

**UNIFORMS:** Each team is responsible for getting its own uniforms. Each team must have 2 different color uniforms (either reversible or 2 sets). Players must be dressed in regulation basketball uppers and **solid-colored** shorts. No cut-offs or other variations. Any player not in uniform will not be allowed to play. Also, any **T-shirt worn under a uniform must be the same color/shade as the uniform.**

**AWARDS:** Suitable awards will be presented to the Tournament Championship team.
