- Tournament style play. All teams are guaranteed at least 3 games.
- Games will be 20 minutes halves with stop time at the on free throws. Overtime will be 2 minutes for the first two overtimes and "sudden death" for the third.
- There will be a short fellowship before each team's first game on Saturday.
- Each team is allotted 2 timeouts per half and an additional timeout at each overtimes. They will not carry over.
- Each participating team in the tournament will be required to provide time/score keeping. The CCU Ambassadors will provide officiating for the games.
- Changes to the roster will not be allowed once it has been submitted, unless approved by the tournament committee. No player is allowed to play on more than one team. There is a maximum of 10 players per team.
- Champions of each division will receive an award.
