

2009 CCU SOFBALL BAT RULES

For safety and fellowship ideas, please follow these rules for using softball bats in the CCU Softball League. If you are not sure about a bat, please refrain from using it until you get approval.

Bats that are allowed:

- Single wall (ex. Demarini Ultimate Weapon)
- Single wall with composite handle only (ex. Demarini White Steel)
- Women's fast pitch single wall (ex. Easton Fast pitch SX35B)
- Men's fast pitch single wall only
- Wooden bats (ex. Rawlings Big Stick)

Bats that are not allowed:

- Baseball
- Multiwall including Double Wall and Triple Wall (ex. Worth ESTs, Worth PSTs, Mizuno Crush)
- Composite (ex. Demarini EVO, Anderson Matrix)
- Composite and Multiwall (ex. Demarini F375, Demarini F2)
- Titanium (ex. Easton Z-Core Ti, Easton Tiphon)
- Titanium and Composite (ex. Miken T22c6)
- Women's fast pitch that are Multiwall, Composite, and Multiwall and composite. (ex. TPS Mendoza FP86)
- Men's fast pitch that are Multiwall, Composite, and Multiwall and composite. (ex. TPS H2 Hybrid)

We do have a bat list which will be on the CCUSports.com website starting Tuesday, May 26. This is the first time we are doing this so please bear with us. FYI, this is an ongoing list because there are a lot of bats out there. Use this as a guide but if a bat is not on this list go with rules above.

Please do not ask about the bats during games, before or after. If you have questions ask by e-mailing us. Please also do not campaign for your bat to be legal. No exceptions. We will be reviewing bats each year.
